**LAST TIME OUT:** The Miners suffered a loss in the season series finale against the Florence Freedom last night in Marion by a 4-2 score, as they settled for a 2-1 series win and a 6-6 season series split against their West Division rivals.

Florence got a 1-0 lead in the top of the first inning on a sacrifice fly, with starter Cole Cook having to leave the game due to an injury. The Freedom would score three times against Andrew Bernstein in the next four innings to take a 4-0 lead, but Heath Renz would nearly complete the rest of the game, pitching a career-best 4 1/3 innings and not allowing any runs of his own.

Offensively, the Miners were stymied by Mike Castellani until the seventh inning, when Taylor Sparks' RBI double off the very top of the left field fence with two men on base made it 4-1. The Miners also got the tying run to the plate in the ninth against Karl Craigie, scoring once on a sac fly by Andy Cosgrove, but could get no closer in suffering just their second loss this month.

**STREAKIN':** Despite the defeat last night, several Miners hitters extended their hitting streaks. Kyle Davis' 14-gamer is the longest streak by a Miner this year, and with a hit tonight he can tie the sixth-longest streak in team history. Yeltsin Gudino carries an 11-gamer into this series, while Taylor Sparks has also hit in nine straight games.

**PLAYOFF PICTURE:** The Miners currently sit 0.5 games behind River City for the second wild card spot. Evansville is just 0.5 games ahead of the Rascals for the first spot after beating River City

last night, with Florence leading the Otters by just one game. The Freedom and Rascals face each other this weekend in Florence, while Evansville hosts last-place Gateway at home.

**SOUTHERN ILLINOIS STARTER:** Marty Anderson will make his third start of the season against Joliet tonight. He is coming off a "quality start" against Schaumburg in which he allowed just one earned run in six innings while striking out seven. He threw seven shutout frames against the Slammers out of the all-star break in a win on July 12, but struggled with his command the second time around on July 31, taking a loss while allowing five walks and three runs in just four innings.

**JOLIET STARTER:** Rookie right-hander Tyler Jones makes his second appearance against the Miners this year, but first in a starting role. The former Eastern Illinois product, who was teammates with Joe Duncan while playing there, took a loss in his last appearance, a start against Lake Erie in which he gave up five runs over five innings. Before that, he got a win with 5 1/3 scoreless relief innings on August 4 vs Schaumburg.

#### **THIS DAY IN MINERS HISTORY: 5-4**

- **2008:** Trailing 6-1 at home against Evansville entering the ninth inning, all hope seemed lost for the Miners.

But what followed was a miraculous comeback, as they scored seven runs in the bottom of the ninth while not making a single out, winning the game on Tim Dorn's walk-off grand slam by a score of 8-6. It remains the largest ninth-inning comeback in team history.

## 2019 MINERS FIELD STAFF

### 3 - MIKE PINTO - MANAGER

The all-time leader in wins by a manager in Frontier League history, Mike Pinto is in his thirteenth season as the Miners' skipper in 2019. The only manager in franchise history, he joined the team for the inaugural 2007 season and has led the Miners to a 663-486 record over twelve seasons. The team's .577 winning percentage ranks first in league history for teams that have lasted more than one season. He has also guided the team to seven playoff appearances (2008, 2010-12, 2014-16), four division titles (2010, 2014-16), and the 2012 Frontier League Championship, while managing the club to a Frontier League-record ten straight winning seasons from 2007-16. He became the league's all-time winningest manager on June 2nd, 2018, when the Miners defeated the Evansville Otters 7-5 at Rent One Park.

In his twelve-plus years in Southern Illinois, 59 former Miners players have signed affiliated contracts, with three (Clay Zavada, Tanner Roark and Brandon Cunniff) making it to the Major Leagues. In addition, three former coaches have had the opportunity to join a MLB organization, while two have moved on to manage other independent league teams.

Before joining the Miners, Pinto spent two years as the manager of the Sioux Falls Canaries of the American Association. Prior to managing in Sioux Falls, Pinto spent three seasons (2002-2004) with the Joliet Jackhammers of the independent Northern League in various coaching capacities, including bench coach, third base coach, pitching coach and player development coordinator. Pinto also served as the head coach of Oakton (Ill.) Community College for three seasons where he posted a record of 119-45. In 2005, he was named Junior College Coach of the Year by the Pitch & Hit Club of Chicago.

Along with his vast coaching experiences, Pinto has also spent time as a scout for the Kansas City Royals. During the offseason he works as a motivational speaker utilized by numerous Fortune 500 companies, specializing in brand strategy, and also serves as the Miners' Chief Operating Officer.

### 14 - STEVE MARINO HITTING COACH

Steve Marino returns to the Miners in 2019 for his second season as the team's hitting coach.

No stranger to Southern Illinois, Marino played his entire five-year pro career in the Frontier League, including the last three with the Miners from 2014-16.

He was named the Miners' first-ever captain in 2016, batting .288 with career-best totals of 23 doubles, 16 home runs and 79 RBIs, earning him both midseason and postseason all-star honors at third base. He also finished his career ranking in the Miners' all-time top-10 in 12 different statistical categories.

In 2017, Marino served as an assistant coach at his alma mater, Stony Brook University in New York, where he worked with the Seawolves' hitters and also ran and organized clinics for high school players.

### 24 - TYLER MARTIN PITCHING COACH

Pekin, Illinois native Tyler Martin returns in 2019 for his second season as the Miners' pitching coach.

Martin has been the Associate Head Coach/Pitching Coach at Robert Morris University in Illinois for the last four years, mentoring a pair of CCAC All-Conference pitchers. He previously served in the same capacity at his alma mater, Cardinal Stritch University.

Martin also has managerial experience, leading the Sheboygan A's of the Wisconsin State League and Langsdorf League in 2014-15, and winning the Langsdorf League title along with WSL Manager of the Year honors in 2014.

He played collegiately at both Cardinal Stritch and Kankakee Community College (IL).

### BRAD BRUSH ATHLETIC TRAINER (SIH)

Brad Brush (MS, ATC, CSCS) is in his third season as the Miners' athletic trainer, provided by Southern Illinois Healthcare. He is a Certified Athletic Trainer by the National Athletic Trainer's Association (1987), and a Certified Strength and Conditioning Specialist by the National Strength and Conditioning Association (2006).

Brush has been employed by SIH since May of 1994 as a certified athletic trainer for Rehab Unlimited and Sportsology for area high schools as well as John A. Logan College athletics.

Brad graduated from Southern Illinois University in 1987, and after receiving his masters degree from the University of Tulsa in 1989, he came back to Carbondale to work as an assistant athletic trainer at SIU from 1989-93.

Originally from Murphysboro, Illinois, he now resides in Anna, Illinois with his two children.
